Minister/Pastor of Youth Ministry

We are looking for someone who has a life-long passion and calling for youth ministry to shepherd, lead and direct the youth ministry as part of the greater KCCC ministry. The candidate must be in full agreement with the Articles of Faith, church constitution, mission and vision of KCCC.

Our mission is to "Manifest Christ ... for His Glory, Make Disciples ... Life on Life."

The youth ministry at KCCC is an integral part of English ministry, the minister/pastor of youth ministry will therefore work closely with and under the supervision of the Lead English Pastor of KCCC, but will report directly to the Senior Pastor of KCCC. The applicant must have a bachelor's degree from a fully accredited Bible college or a graduate degree from an accredited seminary.

Qualifications and Position Requirements:

- **Spiritual Life:** Must exhibit a personal and growing relationship with Jesus, is humble, teachable, and disciplined. Must also demonstrate and maintain a healthy family life.
- **Personality:** Good Christian character with a heart for youth ministry, people person with strong interpersonal and leadership skills.
- Calling: Must be called to youth ministry, love young people, and have a passion for evangelism and outreach, both personally and at the ministry level.
- Language Ability: Must be able to communicate fluently in English. Proficiency in Mandarin Chinese is a plus.
- Experience:
 - a. Good understanding about today's youth culture and the challenges they face;
 - b. Strong discipleship experience and deep passion to build godly relationship with youth and help them to grow spiritually;
 - c. Able to teach, coach, and disciple youth leaders.

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend worship services, prayer service, and related special meetings.
- Prepare and present bi-annual ministry updates and goals for the coming year to the Senior Pastor.
- Coordinate approved fund-raising activities that support special youth activities and trips.
- Stay current with youth ministry practices by reading, attending youth leadership conferences, etc.
- Participate in annual job performance evaluation by Senior Pastor/Personal Committee Chair.
